- 2. Give your opinion on the value and issues of the concept of ME-BYO. (Not more than 400 words)
- 3. Name an issue in public health, healthcare, or medical care that particularly seems to require innovation. Give your opinion on the reason why the very issue requires innovation and what role you would like to play in health innovation. (Not more than 400 words)

- **Purpose and Evaluation Points**

This question aims to comprehensively evaluate the specialized knowledge, logical thinking, problem-solving ability, originality, and future potential required for study at our university using assignment lectures and materials dealing with "ME-BYO." We evaluate participants from perspectives such as awareness of issues in public health and healthcare, the ability to think from new perspectives without being bound by existing frameworks, and the willingness to solve problems.
